Wendy Weninger is the Accreditation Coordinator of the Child and Youth Care Educational Accreditation Board of Canada. She supports post-secondary institutions who are engaged in the accreditation process. Wendy is also a former board member of the CYCEAB having served on the Executive as well as Chair on the Standards Development and Implementation Committee and as a member of the Planning and Priorities Committee.

Wendy holds a BA in Recreation (1984) and a Master of Education degree (2000) from the University of Lethbridge. She started her career in the Child and Youth Care profession over 35 years ago as a summer employee leading a residential recreational program. From there, she advanced to roles of a front-line CYC Worker and the Program Supervisor of a residential facility for youth. Additional roles included supporting therapeutic foster parents and youth mentorship. In 1993 she joined the Child and Youth Care program at Lethbridge College as a faculty member, where she remained until June 2019. While in this role, she led the Child and Youth Care program

at Lethbridge College through the CYCEAB accreditation process during the period of September 2015 to November 2016, with accreditation granted February 2017.

Wendy has also served as Chair of Alberta Child and Youth Care Educational Consortium / ACAT Child and Youth Care Articulation Subcommittee and post-secondary representative on the Child and Youth Care Association of Alberta Certification Committee. She presently does contract training for human services programs to enhance staff professional development in addition to her work with CYCEAB.
